



## 908A – Amrut Fusion

### Indian Single Malt - 50%, 70 cl

"When East meets West": Amrut Fusion is the result of the blending of the two origins, of the meeting between malted barley grown at the foot of the Himalayas and malted and peated barley from Scotland. Aged independently, the two vintages are blended after four years under quasi-tropical temperatures that accelerate the ageing process.

A single malt of great roundness and medium peatiness, not cold filtered and bottled at 50% which is not without reminding some "collectors" of Speyside!



### Tasting Note

**Nose:** Firm, fine. Honey, sandalwood and roasted malt. Candied citrus fruits, frangipane, liquorice and curry.

**Palate:** Powerful, lively. Malted barley, exotic fruits, green liquorice and heady flowers. Finely woody, gingerbread.

**Finish:** Long and mineral. Malted barley, salted butter. Spices, bergamot and cardamom.
